WE WILL NOT require

examination in connection with an investigation, whether as a subject or a witness, without Union representation when representation has been requested by the employee and the employee reasonably believes that the examination may result in disciplinary action.

WE WILL NOT in any like or related manner, interfere with, restrain, or coerce bargaining unit employees in the exercise of their rights under the Statute.
